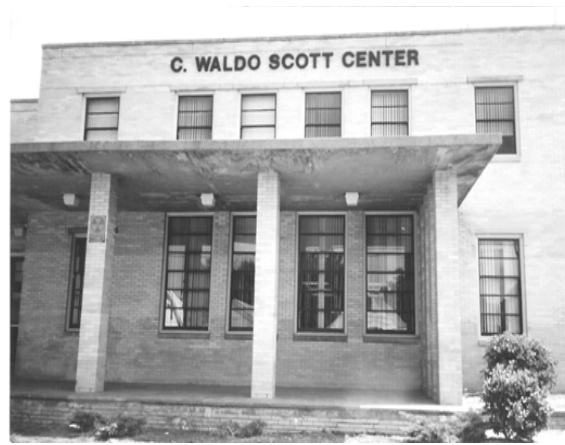

## OUR MISSION

The mission of the C. Waldo Scott Center for H.O.P.E. is to provide HOPE to families, while developing the WHOLE CHILD. This is achieved by providing multi-discipline services to educate and foster the growth and development of youth and families.

The C. Waldo Scott Center is a special place for children and families in Newport News to receive comprehensive services, which are developed to meet the needs of the community. Bringing together educators, health care professionals, social workers, recreation specialist, and community members to provide the education, training, and support needed for young people and their families to develop the skills necessary to take charge of their lives, enhancing positive life skills, health, education, and employability.



## PROGRAMS & SERVICES

Programs at the Scott Center are available to young people ages 6 to 18, and their family members. The Scott Center also provides specific services for special populations when the need and interest arises. While we encourage young people and their families to join the Scott Center, and participate in our programs, individuals may also be referred by schools, community based organizations/agencies (public & private), churches, friends, or family.

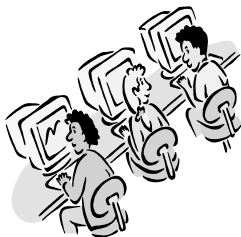

## **Health Services:**

In collaboration with Peninsula Institute for Community Health and the Peninsula Health District our members have access to health/dental education and screenings.

---

## **Case Management:**

The Scott Center provides case management services, which include conducting intakes and assessments, providing individual/group supportive counseling, assisting with program development and implementation, facilitating school/home visits, and providing referrals to other community-based programs.

---

## **G.E.D. Classes:**

In collaboration with the Newport News Public School System, the Scott Center provides instruction for G.E.D. preparation for youth referred by the school system. Program participants also receive job readiness and computer literacy skills.

---

## **After School Program:**

In collaboration with the Newport News Public School System, the Scott Center offers an After School program, for youth attending Newport News Public Schools and are enrolled in the 1st—8th grades. Participants receive academic assistance and skill-building lessons from certified teachers. They also have the opportunity to participate in violin and foreign language.

---

## **Parenting Education:**

The Scott Center provides parenting classes, which utilize an asset development and nurturing curriculum. The Scott Center also provides workshops on various topics to enhance family structure, interaction, and self-sufficiency.

## **Teen Responsibility/Social Skills Groups:**

Scott Center staff facilitates several groups, which promotes social skills, goal-setting, decision making skills, career exploration, teen pregnancy prevention, and substance abuse prevention.

---

## **Creative Services:**

In collaboration with Newport News Parks, Recreation, and Tourism, the Scott Center facilitates instructional recreation and leisure activities. The Scott Center also sponsors three summer camp activities.

---

## **S.U.P.E.R. Saturdays:**

The Scott Center collaborates with Hampton University students who are affiliated with the Sister II Sister program, to facilitate the Saturday mentorship program. The H.U. students also provide enrichment activities for the female participants.

---

## **Community Outreach:**

The Scott Center staff provide services and information through various community outreach efforts, to include participation on various community coalitions, attendance of community health/resource fairs, and attendance of local school and PTA events.

---

## **Scholarship Awards:**

The C. Waldo Scott Center's Board of Trustees' provide high school graduates of the Newport News Public School System and Scott Center members with the opportunity to apply for a scholarship to assist with their efforts to continue their education. The Board has awarded over 15 scholarships to eligible students, based on their academic performance and goals, and community involvement.
